Hope for Highland

Collaboration grant completed with Highland County \$100,000.00 awarded. This will include contracted training with REACH. Adams County declined grant but REACH staff is working with them to re-consider the grant.

Fundraising- Cookbook idea to raise funds. Community contest to come up with recipes to put the book together. Danielle is working on this project. Also it was mentioned to look into the Kroger charity.

Partner with Recovery Council

Community Psychiatric Supportive Treatment (CPST)- Mental health treatment in the home. This is a way to partner for services and pay through Medicaid. Staff would need to be certified as QMHS.

Children's Trust Fund grant review and working with United Way regarding grant. Shared information about partnering with the Reading is Fundamental program.
